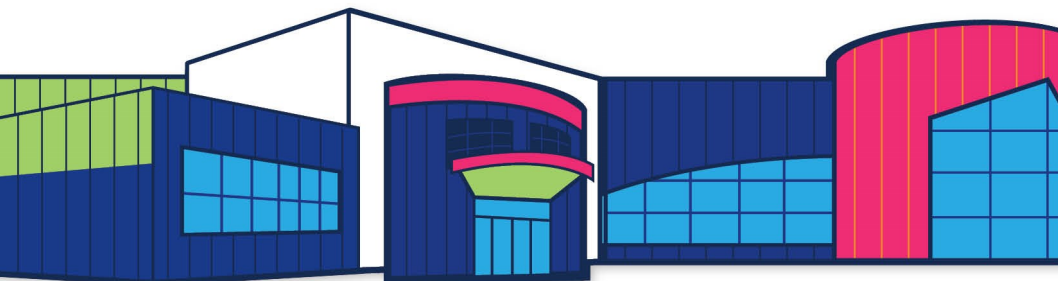

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Winter Play Activities

Snow Flag

Tie white cloths to the end of sticks and hide them around a snowy area for the kids to find.

Spray Paint Art

Fill spray bottles with water and food colouring and draw in the snow.



Target Snowball

Hang a target in the tree or lean against a wall and let the children take aim with snowballs.



Tic Tac Toe

Use sticks and pinecones and make a grid in the snow.



Nature Ice Balls

Freeze natural items such as pine needles, twigs, small stones, etc., into ice and hang outside.



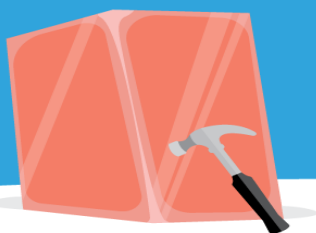
Snow Search

Place an assortment of items in the snow and give children time to collect the items.



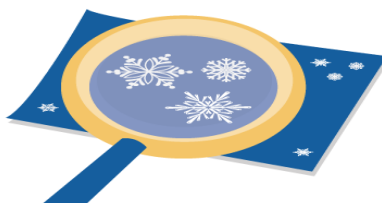
Ice Sculptures

Freeze large slabs of ice in Rubbermaid containers and use food colouring for colour. Use a hammer and nails to sculpt the ice block.



Snowflake Magnifying

Use black construction paper and put snow on top of it. Let the kids use magnifying glass to look at the different snow flakes.
